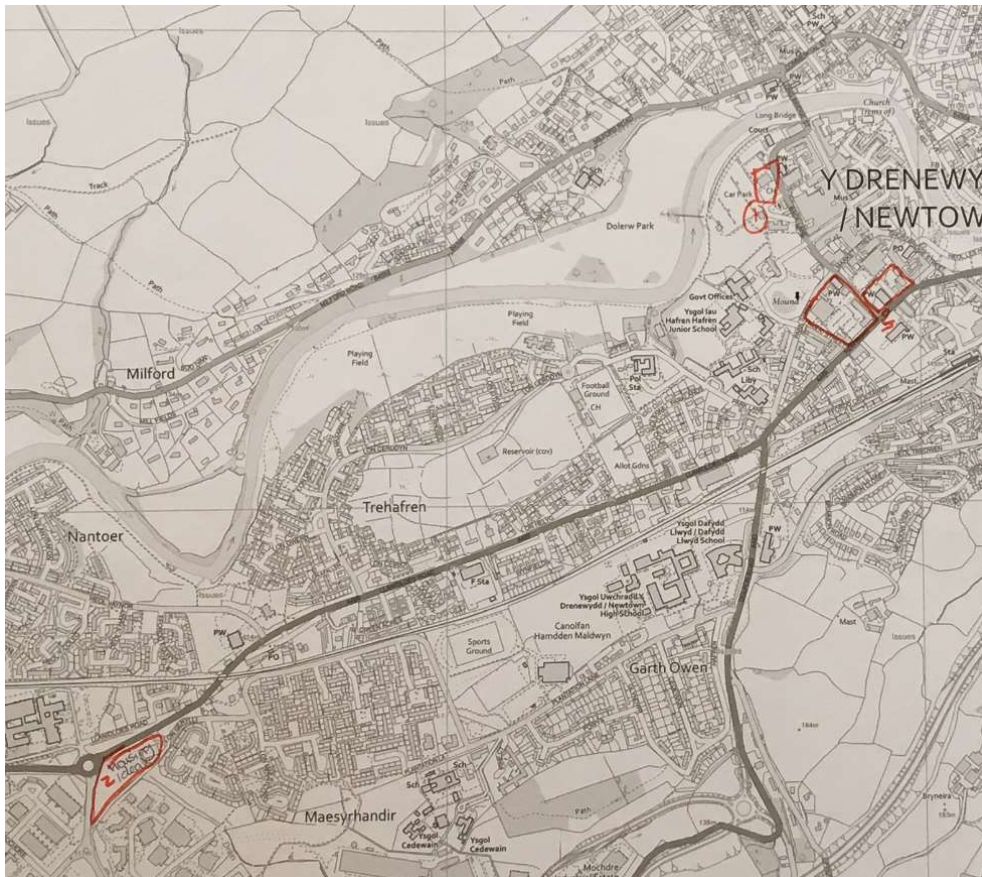
Which current facilities need improving?	Facilities that your neighbourhood lacks?

Northside Hall	Good toy shop
Attenuation Pond behind Garth Owen needs landscaping	Community hall for south ward
Cycle path along Hafren, Garth Owen needs to go somewhere	Indoor play area like “Quakers”
Cycle path into Newtown needs to be safer	Swap shop
Big Pryce Jones and agricultural house buildings – major part of towns history – what’s happening to them? Talk of hotel / business centre – both good ideas. Neat train station. Also St David’s and other discussed churches – would be good to have change of use – community or housing.	Repair café
Improved play area at Maesyrrhandir	Upcycling shop / combined with artists/ refashioning items

Other Issues / Anything missing

Issues	Solutions
Lack of respect for wildlife	Do free bush craft workshops for schools / clubs – Beavers / Cubs to support the young generation life skills. – no academic to “look after their local”
Future street lighting if PCC switch them off	Find sponsors for particular areas – look at solar energy
No changing places toilets	Form an action group – constitute it and apply for grants
Very little presence on trip advisor or digitally	Use Trip Advisor to review cafes, gallery, theatre, sports centre and big up everything Newtown has!
Limited indoor play centre facilities	Create an all-weather play / activity centre – think big – big glass geodome would attract locals and visitors off by-pass
Litter / tidy clean streets	Co-ordinated group of volunteers needed someone to lead
No “one stop” shop for info – what’s on / groups	A co-ordinated noticeboard online / offline
