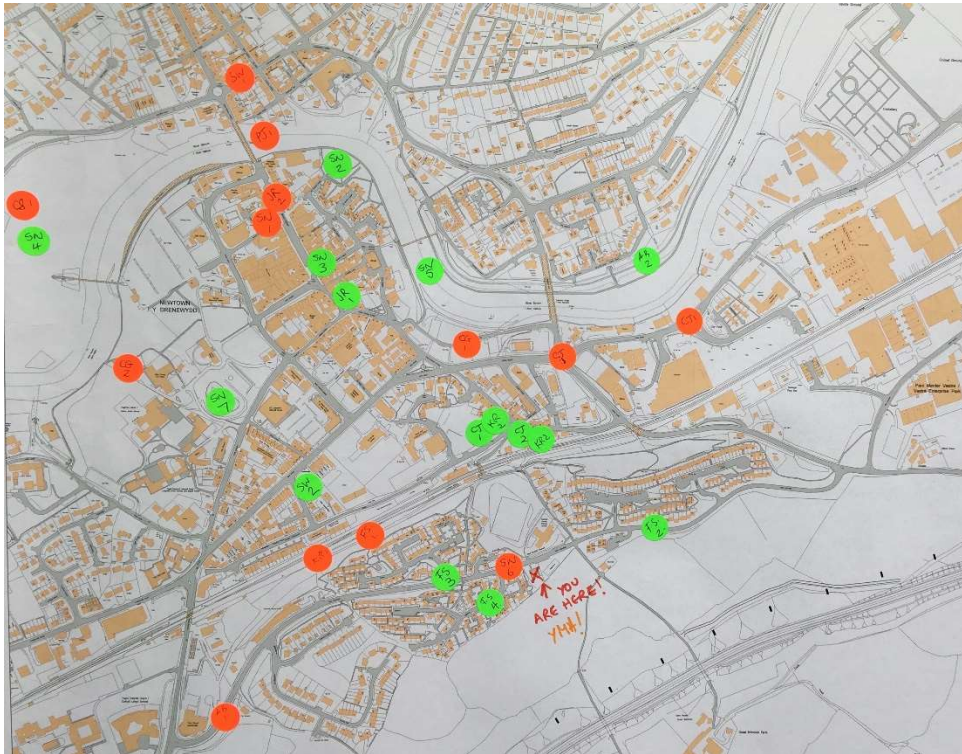

### “The Good Bad and the Ugly ”comments

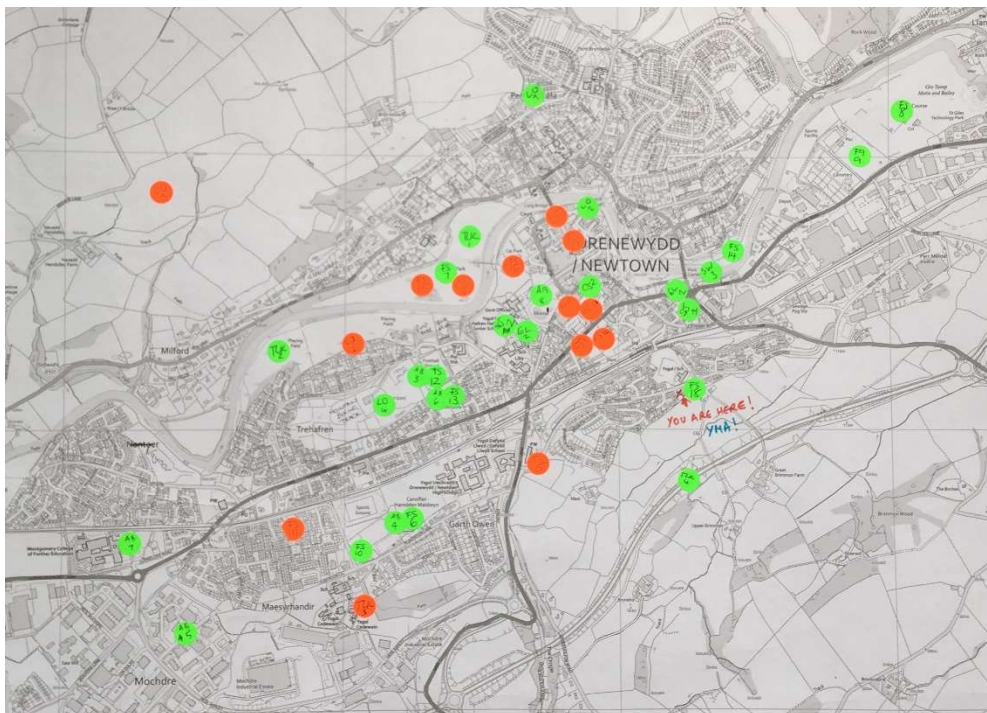

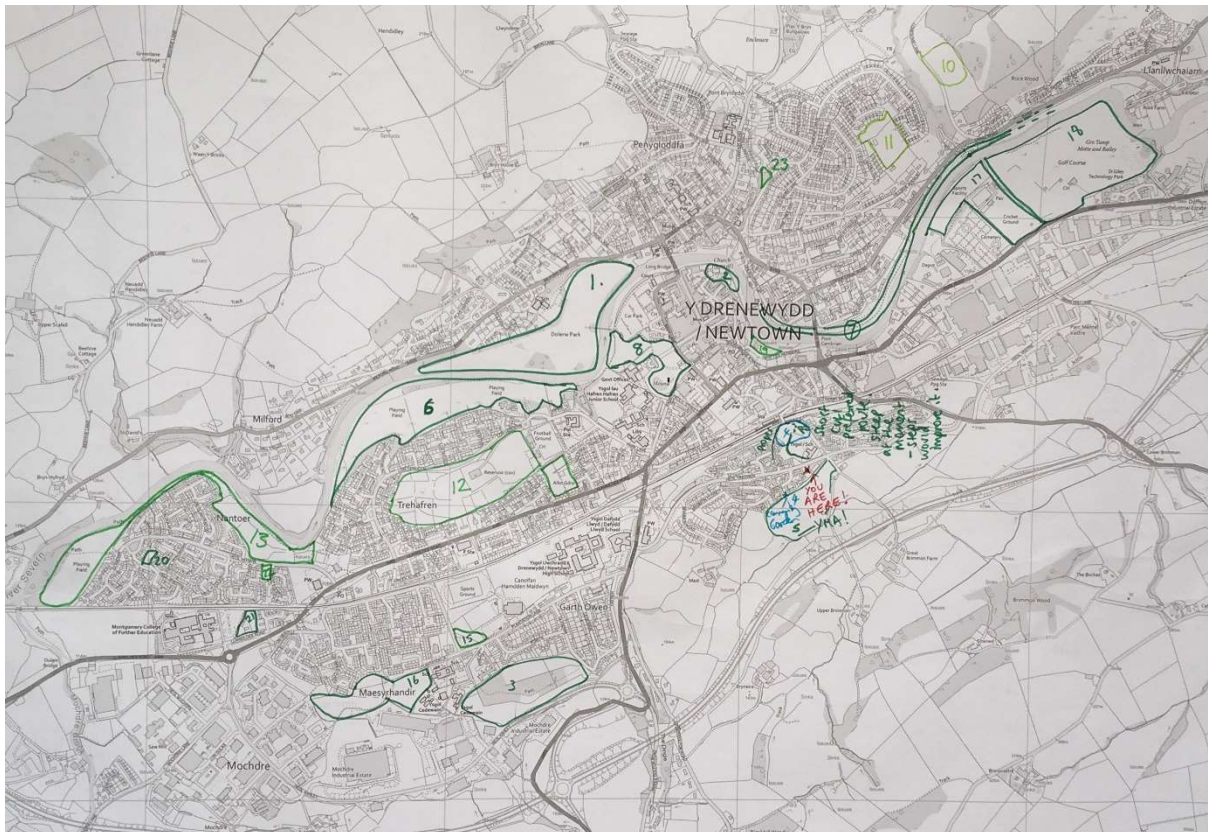

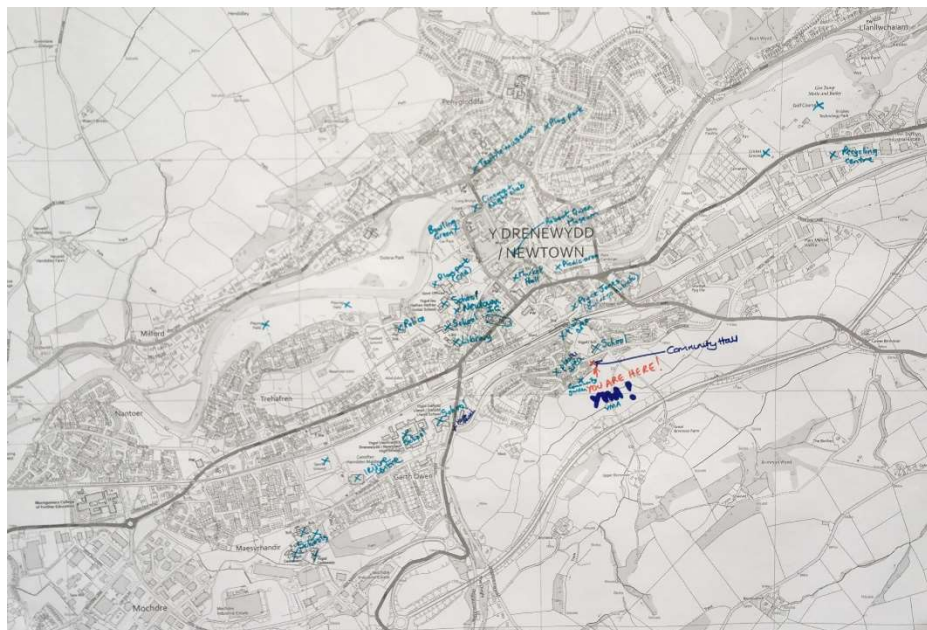

	Local shop is shut (Treowen) – need one! Solution to anti-social behaviour – don't open in evenings – mobile shop?

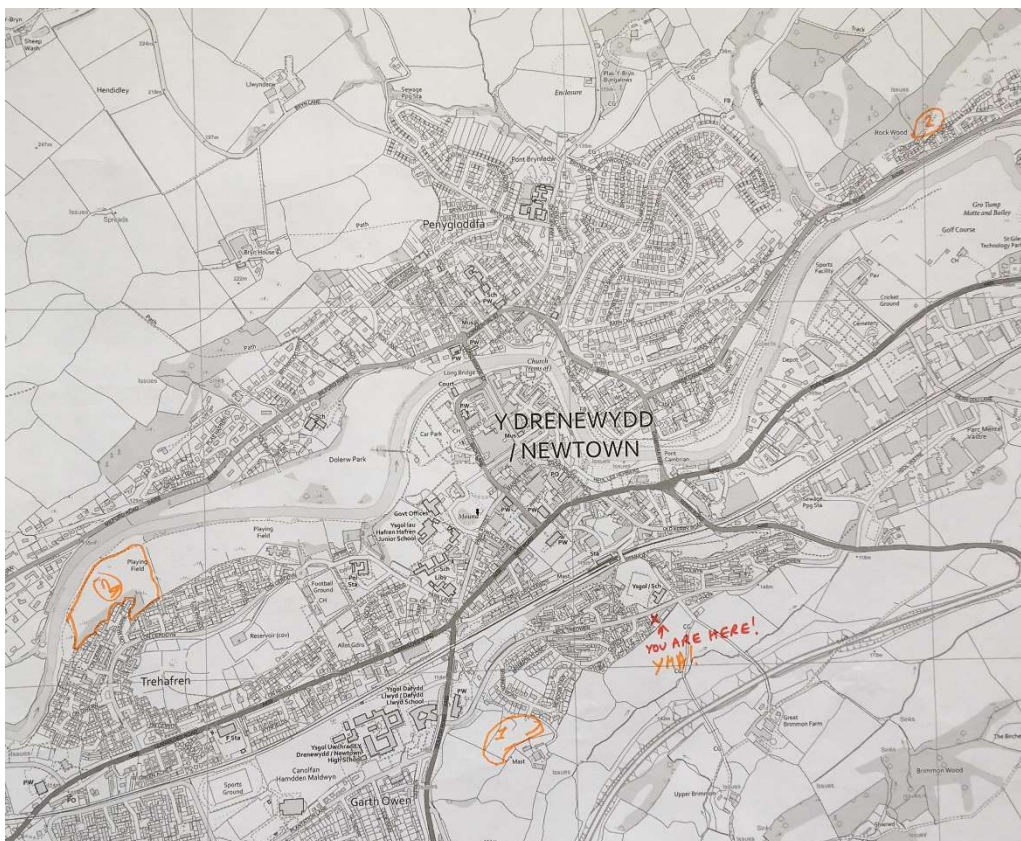
	Indoor climbing wall – large soft play area for older children
