Notes from session

Open Spaces, Play areas & Allotments Today

- If no evidence for the need for allotments we should seek it, who would really like to have an allotment. Convert anecdotal to actual evidence.
- Re the summary of allotment observations:
- The use of an allotment maybe /is recreational; related to mental/physical health; to social contact & related to the production of food for immediate family, neighbors.
- It has only a loose relationship with a wider "food economy." Occasional surpluses occasionally only enter the money economy ... The two functions need disentangling on the plan.

Tomorrow

- Most plans for the "Open Spaces" seem to involve building on them in some way or driving across them to canoe launch points, or build allotments etc. etc. Can we please keep our open spaces OPEN!
- Increase allotment availability if there is a need.

Facilities

Today

- Assets perhaps lack a cohesive theme and each stand well on their own, but don't make a bigger picture.
- Electric vehicles difficult to attract few charge points.
- Good range of facilities

Tomorrow

- Persuade inward investment from more hotels and eating establishments to cater for visitors/conferences – making 'destination Newtown'
- Newtown as 'Electric Town' charge points for casual and destination visitors and residents
- Newtown as a "service centre" great location, good facilities largest town

Footpaths & Cycle Ways

Today

• Some paths fragmented – need linking, train station isolated.

Tomorrow

- Need more river crossing e.g. around Mochdre Brook area. FP or mixed area
- Need accessible path over & around Trehafren Hill to permit families/ handicapped to get out of traffic. This could tie in with with active travel to town in new healthy route.

Character Areas

Today

• Penygloddfa – unused & characterful

Tomorrow

- Penygloddfa branding and marketing as unique or special character
- Possible film set
- Gateway style arrival and departure from Penygloddfa

Town Centre

Today

- A bit retail orientated
- Nice core around Broad Street, High Street, Market Street & Seven Street

Tomorrow

- A future away from retail or a different sort of retail
- Anyway to give a boost to the attractive change to the core.
- Bring housing into town center to boost the indigenous economy.
